Staff Spotlight: Building Reps

Building representatives play an important role in helping our buildings run smoothly. Their responsibilities include:

- showing apartments to prospective tenants
- reserving elevators for smooth tenant move in/outs
- overseeing parking
- managing locker allocations
- conducting regular walkthroughs of common areas to check for maintenance issues

Building reps do a lot, but are not on-site property managers. If you have any problems, we ask you to contact your rental officer first, rather than knocking on your building rep's door.

Ontario Electricity Support Program

If you are a customer of an electricity utility and in a lower-income home, you may qualify for a reduction on your electricity bill.

The Ontario Electricity Support Program (OESP) will reduce the cost of your household electricity by applying a monthly credit directly to your bill. The credit amount will depend on how many people live in your home and your combined household income.



Pest Dos and Don'ts

If you notice pests in your home, don't hesitate to call us! Our pest control technicians are non-judgmental and here to help. We also recommend these tips for preventing pest problems:

Do maintain a clean home- while pests can affect any home, crumbs and clutter can make your home more attractive homes for pests looking for sources of food and shelter.

Do cooperate and follow all necessary preparations advised by the pest control technician. We cannot treat the problems without adequate preparations, like clearing cupboards or moving furniture. CCOC does not charge for pest services, but failing to prepare can result in chargebacks!

Do call us if you have questions about disposing of pest-infested furnishings.

Don't feed wildlife, including pigeons, birds, and squirrels. Birdseed and other food often attract other unwanted guests, including rats!

Don't try to deal with a pest problem with Do-It-Yourself solutions or pesticides. Using store-bought solutions can be more risky to your health and your pets' safety. We have trained in-house pest control professionals who can help. If there's a pest problem, we want to know sooner rather than later so we can prevent it from spreading.

Aging and Accessibility Accommodations

CCOC wants all of our tenants to be able to live and age safely in their homes.

Accommodations in the living space sometimes need to be made for this to happen. If you need a grab bar installed in your washroom or some other change to accommodate your abilities, we can help.

Contact us to explore options at 613-234-4065 ext. 0. We will work with you so you can keep enjoying your home. As no two people have the same mobility needs, we will require a written recommendation from an Occupational Therapist or other professional to determine the appropriate solution.
